Job Sheet

Pasture Lime and Soil Test Program

Deadline to apply is June 27, 2008

The following guidelines will be strictly followed:

1. All interested parties will need to complete an application for cost-share assistance for each individual program.
2. All parties must be land holders of property inside Monroe County.
3. All property must be inside Monroe County.
4. All property must have a soil test on file with the SWCD.
5. All soils tests must have been done after January 2007.
6. No cost share will be paid if the soil test indicates a pH of 6.5 or higher.
7. Cost share will be paid at \$3 per ton.
8. A copy of all scales tickets will need to be on file with the SWCD.
9. Cost share will be paid on no more than 3 tons per acres.
10. Soil Tests will be cost shared at a rate of 50%.
11. ALL projects and receipts will need to be completed before April 1, 2009.
12. The program will be completed and all payments will be made prior to April 30, 2009.
13. All applications must be approved by the board of supervisors before cost share will be paid.
14. A maximum of \$500 per landowner will be paid.

PRIORITIZATION OF APPLICATION

- a. Lands in Bean Blossom Watershed will be given 1st priority
- b. Lands in Indian Creek Watershed will be given 2nd priority
- c. Lands in all other watersheds crossing Monroe County will be given 3rd priority
